Frequently Asked Questions

- How much does the program cost? The cost for U.S. residents is \$675 plus the Strong Manual, User's Guide, and interpretive booklet— approximately \$95.
- What is the program format? The program contains ten modules:
 1. Career development counseling and assessment
 2. Holland's RIASEC theory of personality types and work environments
 3. Components of the Strong Profile
 4. Profile validity
 5. Descriptive statistics and sampling
 6. The General Occupational Themes and the Basic Interest Scales
 7. The Occupational Scales
 8. Reliability and validity of the Themes and Basic Interest Scales
 9. The Personal Style Scales
 10. Interpretation issues, ethics, and cross-cultural applications

The program includes brief interactive assignments, a quiz at the end of each module, and a written interpretation activity.

- How long does it take to complete the program? The program is designed to take the same amount of time as our public programs, approximately 25 hours. It is self-paced. Some participants are able to complete it over a weekend; others take the full 25 hours.
- Is there a deadline for completion? We ask you to finish the program within 90 days of your program start so that you are building on previous learning and not having to re-learn every time you pick it up. The on line learning platform that we use will automatically drop anyone who does not complete the ten quizzes within 90 days. You may be reinstated for one extension. There is a \$125 fee for program reinstatement.
- How much computer knowledge is necessary? You need to be able to turn your computer on and off, and access Microsoft Explorer. The rest is learn as you go. You will be clicking on links to respond to questions, submitting assignments in ordinary word processing, and interacting with the instructor and other participants in virtual classroom settings. We chose Blackboard.com as the platform because it is easy and straightforward. Fewer bells and whistles, more speed.
- How do I get feedback on my work? You will receive immediate feedback on your quizzes, and feedback by email as you submit your answers to the questions in the modules. Instructors are also available by phone.

- Can I contact others in the program? Yes! Participants who wish to do so can have their own personal web pages in Blackboard.com and be listed on a program roster. We also have virtual classrooms and discussion groups on a regular basis where participants get together with the instructor.
- How do I register? You can register one of three ways:
